WHO ARE WE?

The National Biodiversity Network (NBN) – the UK's largest partnership for nature – is a collaboration of UK organisations all committed to sharing biodiversity data and making it freely and publicly available. Our 150+ Network of members ranges from government agencies, research organisations, local environmental record centres, conservation charities, local and national recording groups as well as individual volunteers. All of these, in turn, support the openly accessible internet portal, the NBN Gateway. Currently holding more than 127 million records, it is the largest species database for any country in the world.

THE NBN CONFERENCE AND UK AWARDS FOR BIOLOGICAL RECORDING & INFORMATION SHARING

The National Biodiversity Network holds an annual conference each November. Now in its 16th year, it is a successful forum for Chief Executives, key decision makers, volunteers and students from across the biodiversity sector to come together and share ideas on an equal platform.

This year, the two day conference will be held at National Museum of Scotland, in Edinburgh, on 17 and 18 November 2016. The theme is: **'Going with the flow: Supporting the NBN Data Flow Pathway'**.

As many of our conference delegates are unpaid biological recorders and volunteers, we try to keep our prices low to allow as many of them as possible the opportunity to attend. We can only do this with the generous support of our sponsors.
