We will also be announcing the prizes for our biological recording workshops initiatives, and the competition's categories for winning!



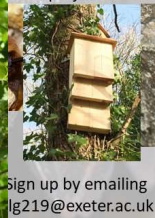
Come down to Peter Lanyon Lecture 5 from 2-3 on Wednesday afternoon!

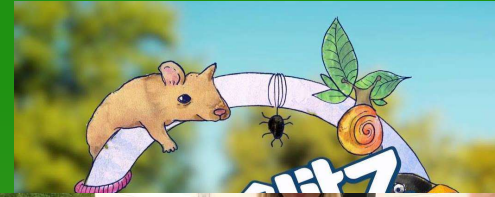
