NBN CONFERENCE 2017

- 2. The Conference will take place on Thursday 16th and Friday 17th November at the National Museum Cardiff.
- 3. The theme of the Conference is "Data what is it good for?" and the programme is now complete and can be found on the <u>NBN website</u> as well as at Appendix 1.
- 4. So far, 141 delegates have registered (as of 23rd October). This is a very similar number to 2016 at this stage, when 152 had registered by 31st October.
- 5. The NBN AGM will be held at the end of the Conference on Thursday and before the Awards ceremony.

NBN ATLAS AND NBN WEBSITE

- 15. As we have the NBN website and three NBN Atlases, managing some of the documentation across the four sites has become problematic. For instance, if we make a change to the Help pages on the NBN Atlas, we also have to make the same changes to the Help pages on NBN Atlas Scotland and NBN Atlas Wales, as the process cannot be automated.
- 16. We therefore took the decision to develop a separate NBN documentation site. This means that the web pages, such as Help, will be held in one central location and, as a result, will only need updating in one place.
- 17. The prototype test site is due to be available for testing on 24th October. Once approved, we will be looking to roll this out very quickly and in time for the NBN Conference.

OTHER ACTIVITY

- 18. The launch of the new Communications Strategy will take place in early 2018.
- 19. The Senior Communications Officer and Communications Officer are planning a Communications workshop / meeting in February / March. Communications teams from NBN member organisations will be invited to the event which will launch the Strategy as well as highlight key activities for the NBN year. The idea is to foster greater links and joined up communications across the NBN to help support each other.
