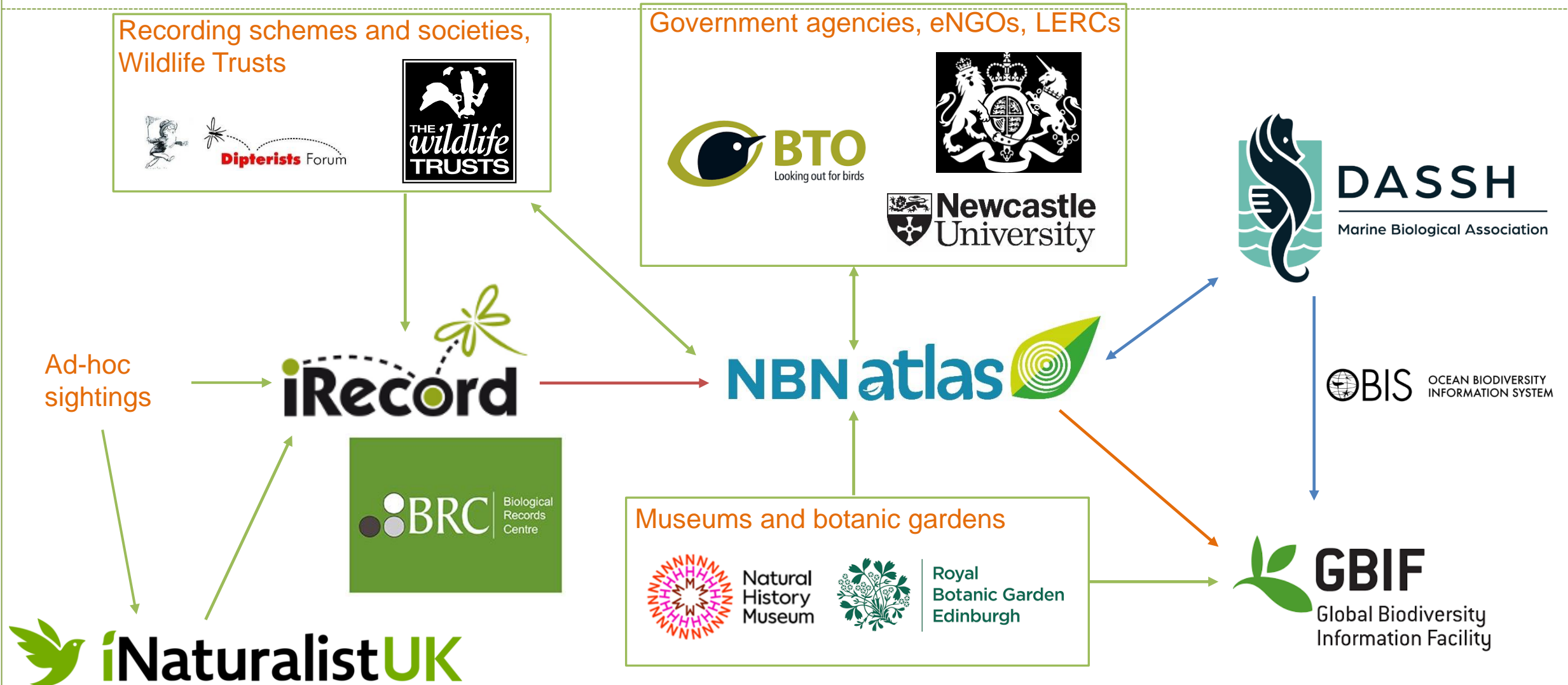

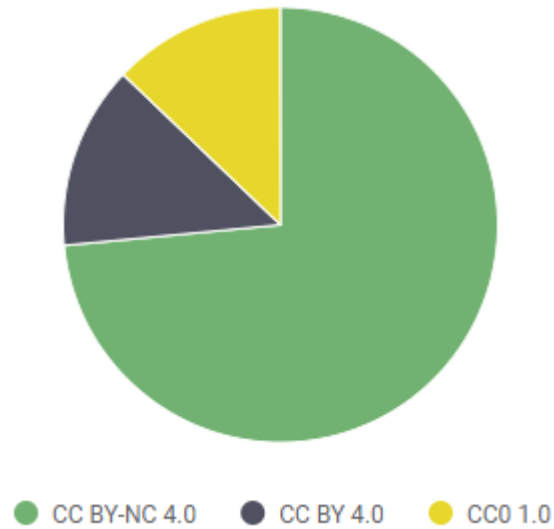

Data Flow

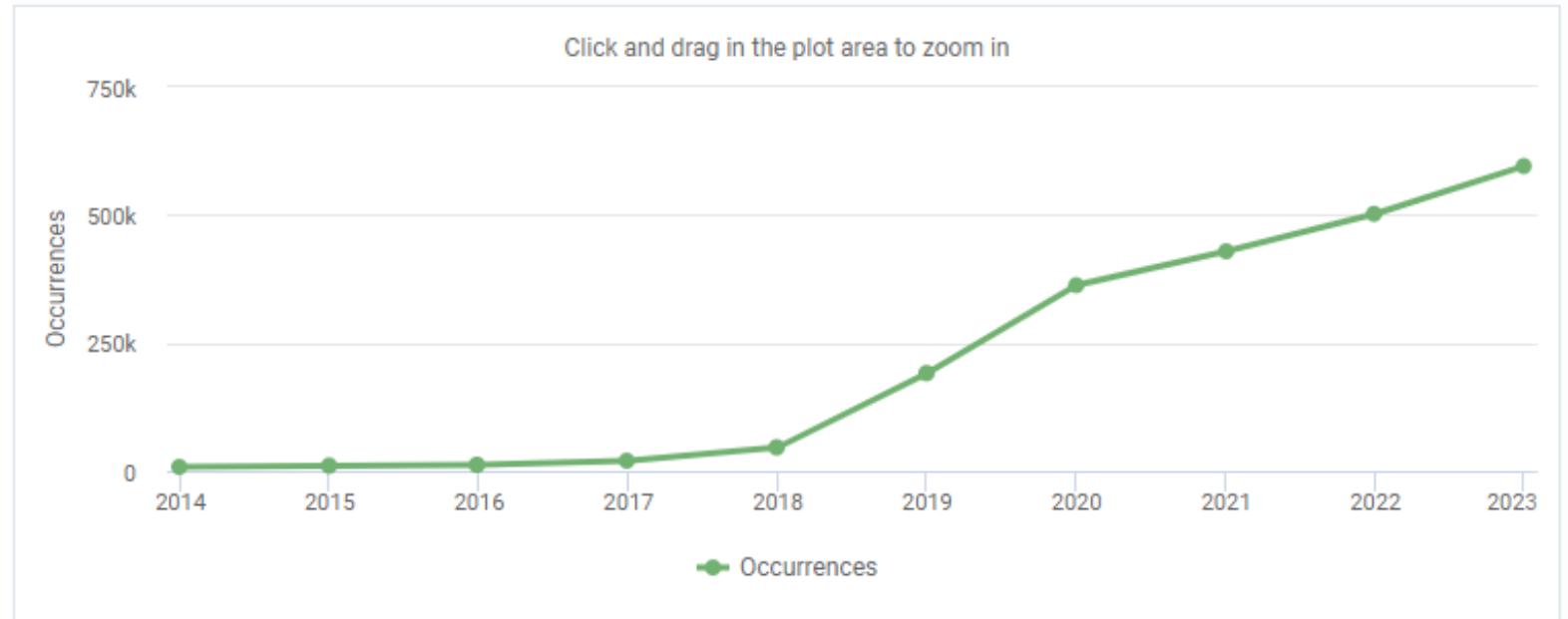


OCCURRENCES PER LICENCE

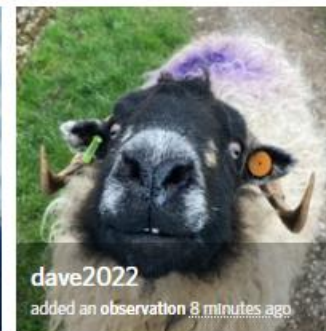
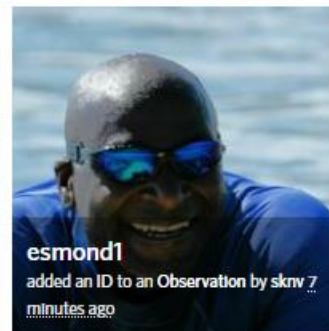
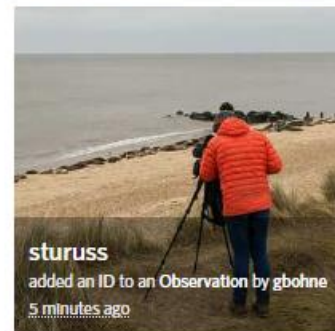
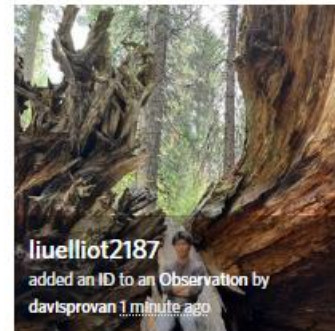
OCCURRENCES PER YEAR

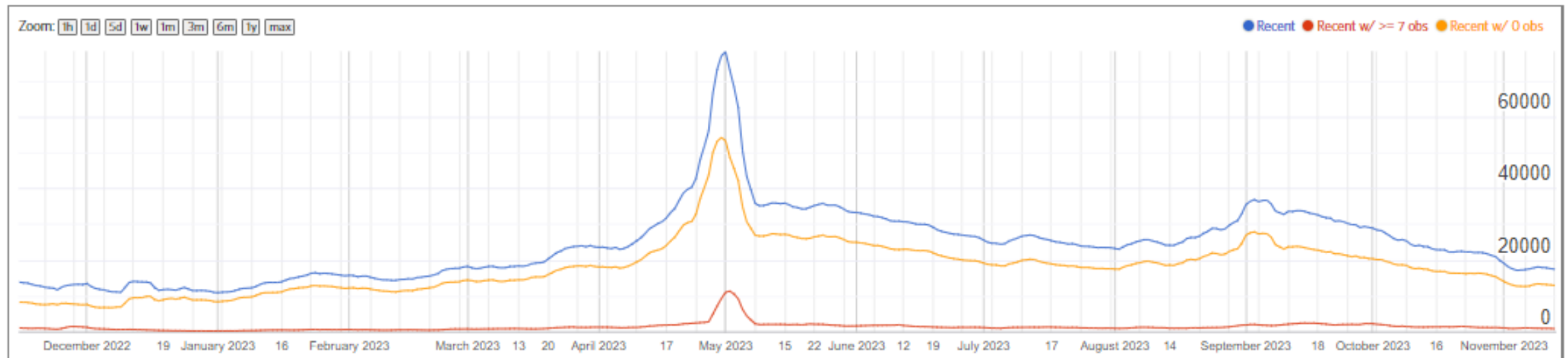

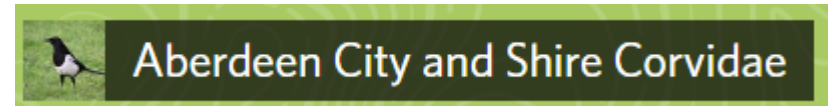
